In November 2025, InES will host two one-week international project meetings, welcoming partners from Central Asia and Africa. We are seeking a dedicated student assistant to provide comprehensive support in the organization and execution of these events.

Tasks:

1. Supporting the comprehensive logistical planning for the project meetings, including the organization of excursions to relevant industry partners.
2. Providing direct assistance to the guest academics from our partner universities throughout their stay in Ingolstadt.
3. Developing newsletter articles and social media updates to document the highlights of the project meetings.
4. Assisting the project team with the overall coordination and smooth execution of the events.
