

Notes on application for the course of Beng programme Architecture

In the Bachelor's programme **Architecture** admission is determined by an aptitude test procedure, which determines whether, in addition to the basic qualification demonstrated by the acquisition of the university entrance qualification (e.g. secondary school certificate), the suitability for the special qualitative requirements is given, which allows a successful course of studies to be expected.

This degree program is specifically designed for international applicants. From the 5th semester onwards, international and German-speaking students study together, primarily in German.

The aptitude test is carried out by evaluating the following criteria by means of points

1. **average grade of the university entrance qualification (HZB) (weighting 0,3)**
2. **grade for work samples (weighting 0,7)**

The aptitude test will take the form of an online submission of work samples in digital format (PDF format). There will be no in-person examination.

The following documents must be submitted for the aptitude test:

1. **University entrance qualification** (e. g. Higher School certificate) or **VPD from Uni-Assist**
2. **Three work samples**
Work samples include drawings, paintings, prints, studies of form, color, and objects, photographs, journeyman's pieces, sculptures, and digital image manipulations. Digital submissions should be in the form of photographs or scans of the work. The work samples will be evaluated based on the criteria of idea, concept, quality, and creativity. Grades from 1 to 5 will be awarded.
3. **Declaration** that the submitted work samples were created independently
→ **Total length of the application portfolio: max. 10 pages!**

Suitability is considered established if the aptitude test is rated at least with an overall grade of "good" (2.5).

Required Language Skills:

- Englisch Level B2 (until enrollment)
- German Level A2 (till the end of the 2nd semester)
- German Level B2 (till the end of the 5th semester)

Information for applicants from third countries (outside the EU and EEA):

The regulations for international orientation and selection procedures also apply. In addition to the documents mentioned above, an official identification document (e.g., passport) must be submitted. Selection interviews will also be conducted. The faculty will automatically inform you of your interview date via email.
