

Information on Applying for the Sustainable Civil Engineering Program

Admission to the **Sustainable Civil Engineering** program is determined through a selection process. Basic eligibility is demonstrated by holding a high school diploma or equivalent. The process also assesses whether applicants meet the program's specific academic requirements, which are necessary for successful completion of the program.

The selection process is based on a scoring system that evaluates the following criteria:

1. **average grade of the university entrance qualification (HZB)**
2. **Writing sample: Letter of motivation**
3. **SAT score (optional)**

The following documents must be submitted for the eligibility review:

1. **average grade of the university entrance qualification (HZB)**
2. **Letter of Motivation:**
As part of the "Letter of Motivation" assignment, applicants are required to write an essay on the topic "Why do you wish to study Sustainable Civil Engineering at Technische Hochschule Ingolstadt (THI)?"
This assignment is designed to assess the applicant's personal motivation, suitability for the program, and understanding of sustainable civil engineering. In addition, the ability to present ideas in a structured manner and linguistic expression are taken into account.
The submission must be in text form (max. one page, max. 500 words).
Evaluation is based on the criteria of motivation and relevance to the program, academic interest, ability to reflect, as well as structure and expression. A total of 0 to 20 points can be awarded.

Required language skills:

- English Level B2 (must be demonstrated by the time of enrollment)
- German Level A2 (by the end of the second semester at the latest)
- German Level B2 (by the end of the fifth semester at the latest)

Information for applicants from third countries (outside the EU and EEA):

The Regulations for International Orientation and Selection Procedures also apply here. In addition to the documents listed above, you must submit an official identification document (e.g., passport).

Selection interviews will also be conducted. The faculty will automatically notify you by email of the date and time of your selection interview.
